“Adopt Your Favorite Candidate” This Election Weekend
San Diego Humane Society offers half-off adoption fees for all animals, Nov. 5-8.



SAN DIEGO — While thousands of San Diegans prepare to cast their votes on Election Day, San Diego Humane Society invites the community to put “pawlitics” aside for a cause we can all agree on – give pets a second chance – “Adopt Your Favorite Candidate.”

From Nov. 5 to Nov. 8, San Diego Humane Society and the San Diego County Department of Animal Services are hosting an adoption promotion. For this period only, adoption fees will be slashed in half for all animals, all ages and breeds.

Every animal adopted from San Diego Humane Society is spayed/neutered, current on all vaccinations, microchipped, and is sent home with a certificate for a free veterinary exam, 30 days of worry-free pet insurance from Trupanion and his/her first bag of pet food from Purina. Adopters also receive a 10 percent-off discount at Muttique, which is located at San Diego Humane Society’s San Diego Campus.

“Adopt Your Favorite Candidate” highlights the importance of pet adoption in San Diego County. Nearly 16,000 homeless animals that entered San Diego Humane Society facilities in the past year were adopted. There are nearly 400 homeless animals currently available for adoption at San Diego Humane Society’s three campuses and satellite adoption centers.
