San Diego Humane Society Reduces Adoption Fees During Academy Award Adoption Promotion



SAN DIEGO — In honor of the Academy Awards, San Diego Humane Society has made their animal-themed selection for Best Picture in hopes of shedding some light on adoptable pets at its shelter.

This Academy Award adoption promotion, which runs February 26-28, will feature a \$20 adoption fee for all adult animals (age 7 months and older) at all San Diego Humane Society campuses and locations. This fee covers the animal's microchip, current vaccinations, spay/neuter procedure, and a certificate for a free veterinary exam.

There are currently more than 600 animals at San Diego Humane Society's three campuses and satellite
