SAN DIEGO HUMANE SOCIETY TRAINS FUTURE ANIMAL CRUELTY INVESTIGATORS AT HUMANE ACADEMY

SAN DIEGO —San Diego Humane Society is hosting the Animal Law Enforcement Academy (basic), a 10-day intensive training course for future animal welfare investigators. As a part of this Humane Academy, more than 50 attendees will participate in mock animal crime investigation scenarios on Friday, Oct. 21. San Diego Humane Society is inviting the media* to witness these mock scenarios, allowing an inside look into the skills required to become a humane investigations officer in California.



This is the only Humane Academy offered in Southern California, and one of only two in the state.
