What: Animal Law Enforcement Academy

San Diego Humane Society is hosting the Animal Law Enforcement Academy, a 10-day intensive training course for future animal welfare investigators. As part of this Humane Academy, more than 50 attendees will participate in mock animal crime investigation scenarios. This course can satisfy the requirements mandated by section 14502 of the California Corporations Code for appointment and reappointment as a humane officer.
