San Diego Humane Society Introduces Career Camp and Farm Camp this Summer

Kids and teens to get real-world experience working with animals at camp

SAN DIEGO — Kids and teens can roll up their sleeves and get hands-on experience working with animals during camp this summer. San Diego Humane Society is proud to officially launch two, new summertime programs: Career Camp and Farm Camp.

Career Camp

Two career camps will be offered for teenagers going into 9th through 12th grades. Each day of Career Camp will focus on a different career path at SDHS, including Humane Law Enforcement, veterinary medicine and animal training. Activities, demonstrations and presentations will showcase "a day in the life" of these animal shelter professionals and show the impact each career makes on the life of a shelter animal.

"Our Career Camp gives teens hands-on, real-world experience," said Amelia Curtis, education manager for San Diego Humane Society. "It also teaches kids invaluable lessons about our responsibility to protect and care for all animals. Some may even be inspired to pursue animal-related careers!"

Farm Camp

Farm Camp will be held at the Escondido Campus for children ages 7 to 11 years old. At this specialized camp, children will enjoy interacting with farm animals such as horses and pigs and learning about the care they need.

In addition to Career Camp and Farm Camp, our annual Animal Adventure Camp will also be offered this summer. Animal Adventure Camp gives children ages 5 to 13 years old a fun and interactive opportunity to learn compassion and respect for all living beings. At the week-long



camp, campers will play games, make crafts and be exposed to hands-on animal activities with dogs, kittens, guinea pigs, bunnies and more.
