## SDHS Extends Hours for Federal Employee Pet Food Distribution

**SAN DIEGO** — San Diego Humane Society will offer free pet food to federal employees affected by the temporary government shutdown Monday, Jan. 14 through Friday, Jan. 18, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. PAWS San Diego, a program of San Diego Humane Society, will have temporary distribution centers set up at all three SDHS Escondido. campuses in Oceanside and San Diego.

Two bags of pet food will be provided to each family who can show proof of federal employment. All pet food will be available on a first come, first served basis while supplies last.
